



# Introduction

ClickGaGa brings internet radio listening to your desktop.  
You can listen to and record any internet broadcast.  
ClickGaGa is free.

## **The ClickGaGa let you go back in time.**

While listening, when you hear a clip you like, you want it recorded from the beginning, but the beginning is already gone. ClickGaGa remembers the beginning and let you have the recording from the start. ClickGaGa includes timers for automatic operation you can record or change stations and other features of your radio on fixed times or periodically.

ClickGaGa connects directly to the radio stations. No hidden complex quality destroying links.

# Operating ClickGaGa

**trimming tool.**  
Click to trim the last saved recorded clip

**Genre Drop Down List**  
Select Genre to see a list of stations on the stations drop down list.

**Stations Drop Down List**  
Select the station to hear and record.  
A URL of a station not in the list, can be keyed in and played.

**Play/stop button**  
Click to listen to the station selected. When playing click to stop playing

**Prerecording Check Box.**  
On prerecording the sound played is being recorded constantly, however only short period of recording is being kept. The final recording clip includes the prerecorded clip at its beginning.

**Shut down**



**Prerecording time**  
Edit to set the prerecording, time. (seconds)

**Playing Timer**  
Measure Playing time. To Reset this timer double-click

**Play Pause/Resume button**  
Click to pause receiving. When pausing click to resume receiving.

**Record/Stop Button**  
Click to start recording continuously. When recording click to stop recording

**Recording time.**

**Record Pause/Resume button**  
Click to pause recording. When pausing click to resume recording.

**Volume Control**  
Drag this handle up and down to adjust the volume of the playback. (Recording volume does not change.)



# Operating ClickGaGa

## General:

ClickGaGa will assist you by enabling and disabling buttons and other controls according to the current status. For example when the radio is playing you can not change station.

## Listen to a station:

- select the genre on the [genre drop-down list](#).
- Select the station on the [stations drop-down list](#).
- Click the [Play/stop Button](#)
- Enjoy



## Alternatively:

- Key-in the URL of a station into the “stations drop down list box”.
- Click the [Play/stop Button](#)
- Enjoy





# Operating ClickGaGa

## Prerecording:

When activated (Prerecording checkbox checked), a preset time length clip of audio, will constantly be recorded. When you save your recorded song, the constantly recorded clip will be added at the beginning of your saved song. This way you can have a recording of your song from the beginning even if you have clicked the recording button after the song is already playing.

- Before Playing enter the prerecording time it should be long enough for you to decide if you want to record a clip you hear.
- Check the Prerecording Check Box.
- Select genre
- Select station
- Click the play button.





# Operating ClickGaGa

## Recording :

- While Listening to a station, click the Record/stop Button
- To End a recording click the Record/stop Button.  
The save to file dialog will come up, select the directory and file name of your clip and save your recording. Once saving is done, you are back at playing mode. If prerecording is on (Prerecording Check Box is checked)the prerecording restarts.
- You can automatically record clips broadcasted on defined dates and times using the timers on the timers tab.

Note: The recording volume is set by the broadcasting station, changing playback volume does not affect the recording volume.

## Accessory features

- Network is an unstable resource, specially wireless networks.  
When the ClickGaGa lose its audio signal, it tries to recover automatically. When the play-back stops occasionally, give ClickGaGa couple of minutes to recover, if it does not restart after a while, click the Play Start/stop button to stop and then click again to restart manually. When recording, better shut down internet explorer, or any other application which requires network resources.
- You can have the ClickGaGa stay on top and never be hidden by other windows. On the setup tab check the “Stay on top” check-box.
- To time the recording, you can double click the [Playing Timer](#). The timer display, will restart from zero.

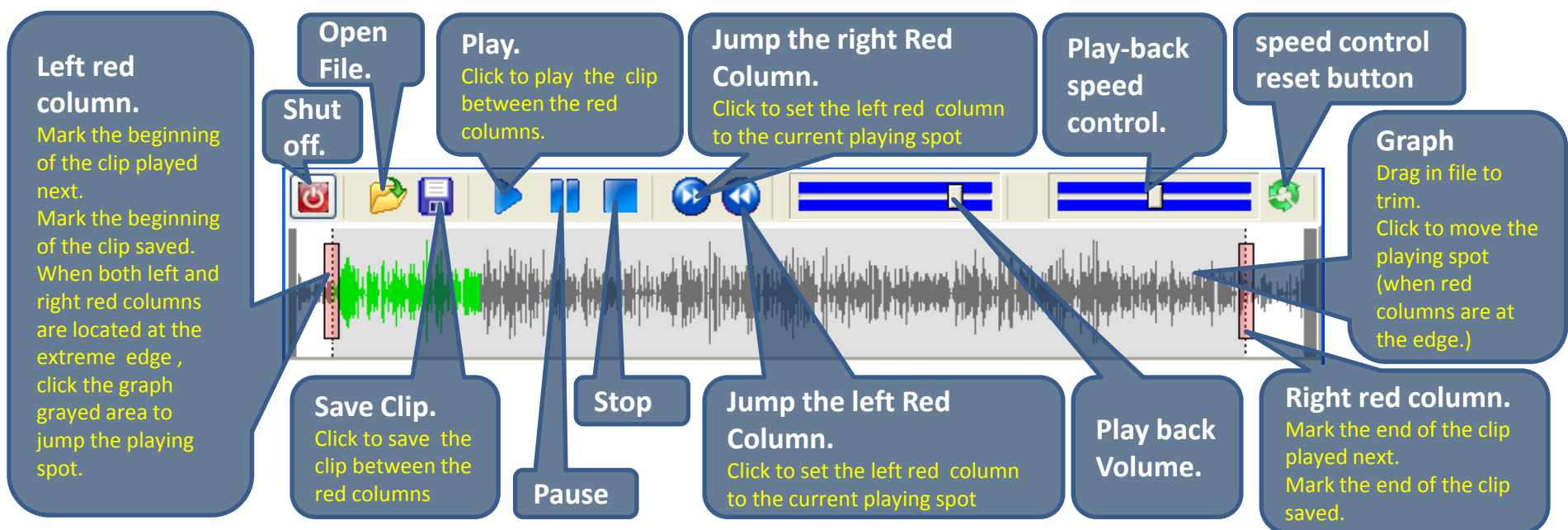

# ClipGaGa Outline

## Trim your Recording :

- Using the prerecording feature, your clip will most probably include at its Beginning some recording you don't care to keep. Use the accessory program **ClipGaGa** to trim your recording to start and end at the moments of your preference.
- Language learning.**  
ClipGaGA enables easy selection of a short clip in a recording and repeatedly listening to the selected short clip.  
ClipGaGa provides a control to set the playback speed.

# Operating ClipGaGa

## Operating ClipGaGA:

- Click the trimming tool button on clickGaGA to trim the last saved recording file. To trim other files, Open the file to be trimmed using the open file button, or drag and drop the file to be trimmed to the darkened area on the ClipGaGA window. A graphic presentation of your clip will be displayed.
- Play your file and while listening watch the graph turned green on the portion you have been listening to.
- On the left and right edges of the darkened panel you will notice vertical bars.  
Drag the left bar to the beginning of the clip you want to save and the Right bar to the end of your clip.
- You can send each bar to the currently played location on the graph by clicking the “fast move” buttons.
- Click the “Save Button” to save the clip which is in between the bars.
- Start playing after moving the bars to confirm the start and end of your clip.
- On initial play when the bars are at the edges of the panel at start, you can click the graph to jump and play other piece of your clip.





## The Timers Tab

### Description:

- The three timers on the timers tab automatically manipulate all of the features of ClickGaGa at predetermined times.
- Beside the obvious use of recording certain programs on predetermined time, you can have more fun by changing music genre automatically every 20 minutes. You set one timer to kick in on the hour, you set the second timer to kick in on the 20 minutes of the hour and you set the third timer on the 40 minutes of the hour.
- If you have one favorite station for music and another one for news which is being broadcast every hour, you can set your news station to kick in on the hour and then set the second timer to 5 minutes after the hour, so that you hear your favorite music for the rest of the time.  
Please note, it may take about one minute to reconnect to a station.



**Note:**-The system will let you enable timers only when the settings make sense. The “Timer Enabled” button is disabled as long as the settings are not set for proper operation.

# The Timers Tab

## Set timers:

- Select the genre and the station.
- Check the start/stop check boxes, and select times for start/stop. You can check either start or stop or both of them.
- Select the operation mode: either Prerecording, Recording or play.
- Set the volume.
- Changing the volume is optional. Check the volume checkbox on the timer.
- Click the timer Enable/Disable button.



## Repeat:

- The repeat option enables repeating operations periodically. To activate check the repeat checkbox.
- Select the Hourly option to repeat the operation each hour. In this option the system ignores the date and the hour set.
- Select the Weekly option to repeat the operation every week on the day of the week. In this option the system ignores the day in the month, the month and the year.
- Select the monthly option to repeat the operation every month on the day of the month. In this option the system ignores the month and the year. When Selecting the 31<sup>st</sup> day of the month months with less then 31 days will not be activated. In this option the system ignores the year setting.
- Select the yearly option to repeat the operation each year on the day set.

## Install ClickGaGa

### *System Requirements:*

- Windows XP and up. (earlier versions not tested).
- DirectX- DX 9 and up. (Free to download and install from Microsoft).

### *Installation:*

Run the installation program and follow the on-screen instructions.

During installation your system is being checked for the presence of DirectX and Internet explorer.

# Internet Radio Stations

The accessible radio stations are stored in a text file called stations.ini  
You can find station files on our [internet site](#).

We will publish from time to time updated station files, we also encourage our users to share their favorite station files with our community.

To edit and update your stations, on the setup tab click the menu “Stations..> /Edit”. Windows notepad will then run with the stations.ini file. This file resides in your system data directory. A backup file will be automatically created; the backup file name is: “Stations.ini.bu” (previous versions are erased).

The “Stations.ini” file is divided to sections. Each section presents a genre. For example the pop section starts with the line [pop]. Each line in a section presents a station.

After editing the stations.ini file and saving it, click on the setup tab the “Stations..> reload” menu. The files.ini saved will be loaded and activated.

## Internet Radio Stations Add/Delete a station

A station pointer line in the stations file has two parts. The parts are divided by '=' the equal sign.

**Note: spaces between the '=' and the URL are not allowed.**

For example, the WKAR Jazz station:

NPR Jazz: WKAR=http://mozart.wkar.msu.edu:80/wkar-jazz

This part is free text, you may want to use it for the name and a short description of the station.

This part is the URL of the station.



## The “Add Station” tab

***NOTE: The “Add Station” tab is disabled when the radio is playing, Stop playing to access its features.***

The add station tab presents a fast tool to add station to the stations list. Adjustments to your stations list and genre list can be achieved using a simple text editor. The default editor is the windows text editor notepad. You can edit your stations file by clicking the “Edit stations button”.

Quick adding station can be done by filling the fields of the URL and the station description and clicking the “Add stations button”. ClickGaGa will check the validity of the URL and enable the Add stations button when a valid URL is filled in.

The “Test URL” button will activate the URL and let you confirm it by listening to the station.

***After Adding stations or editing the stations file click Reload stations to activate the edited file.***





## The “Set Up” tab

***NOTE: The setup tab is disabled when the radio is playing, Stop playing to access its features.***

The quality of the sound is governed by the power of your computer, the bandwidth of your internet connection and the quality of the broadcast. Timing problems are governed by the power of your computer and your internet connection. Timing problems will show as short blimps or repetition in the playback sound. The recording will mostly be flawless.

The items on the setup tab are all related to sound quality . The advanced fields should not be changed unless you have trouble with the sound quality or you want to reduce the recorded file size. To improve performance, set the data directory you find on the setup tab. For best performance, set the data directory to a directory on a disk which will be used exclusively for your radio recordings. The disk should not be fragmented and have plenty of free space. (Gigabytes).

Good quality music files are big. The “Temp File Dir” points to the directory in which temporary recording files are stored. The default directory, is the applications data directory set by your operating system.

To reduce recording file size (and the quality of the recording) Set the “sampler sample rate” to a lower number 16000 is low and 8000 is even lower.

## The “Set Up” tab

During quality recording, close all other programs specially programs which access the internet or have intensive disk activity.

Timing faults will happen because windows is not real-time operating system. Less then 10 short faults an hour are acceptable. If you have more then 10 faults, you may want to reduce the “Sampler Sample Rate” to 22050, (the default is 32000) The sound quality of your recording will be reduced to some degree, but you have to be a sound connoisseur to really notice and care about it. If you do care about it, use a better computer and a better hard disk.
